

Alcohol & COVID-19





- In March 2020, take-away sales increased by ↑27.6% for wine, ↑26.4% for beer, and ↑14% for cider and malt beverages
- In June 2020, total alcohol sales were still 个21% higher than the year before




 26x more off-premises alcohol retailers than public high schools



Estimated total alcohol-related violent crimes per 1000 people from 2016-2018: 14.59




Local licensing authority: Joint local/state licensing and regulatory powers



CASE STUDY: Baltimore







Total alcohol outlets: 1,209

Off-premises outlets: 646

- 1 outlet per 933 people
- 26x more off-premises alcohol retailers than public libraries
- 16x more off-premises alcohol retailers than public high schools



Estimated total alcohol-related violent crimes per 1000 people from 2016-2018: 36.81



Local licensing authority: Exclusive state licensing authority, concurrent local regulatory authority

Safer Alcohol Sales: Local policy solutions that specify the number, density, and sales and service practices of alcohol outlets.

Benefits of Safer Alcohol Sales Policies

- Makes communities safer: Results in safer communities with fewer drinking-related crimes and injuries
- Reduces excessive drinking: Cost-effective ways to reduce excessive drinking by limiting the physical availability of alcohol
- Reduces illegal drinking: Effective strategies for reducing drinking among underage youth

What Cities Can Do



Many cities can regulate alcohol outlet density and service practices through licensing authority, zoning, and/or nuisance powers

Rules for alcohol outlets can reduce excessive alcohol consumption and related harms
